Retired South Dakota State Football Coach

John Stiegelmeier (Coach Stig) is a Selby, SD native and began his coaching career as a student assistant with SDSU in 1979. After a brief stint at other universities, he returned to SDSU in 1988 as the secondary coach and recruiting coordinator. He worked his way through the coaching ranks ultimately becoming the head coach of the Jackrabbits

through the coaching ranks ultimately becoming the head coach of the Jackrabbits in 1997. Coach Stig ended his 26 year head coaching career in January 2023 with a school record 199 wins, the 2022 Eddie Robinson Award winner as the FCS Coach of the Year and his 2022 team won the FCS national championship 45-21 over NDSU.

Coach Stig will share his stories of being a coach of many student/athletes and the rewards and difficulties of being the head coach of a college football team.
